#### **AGRAGAMI AS A TEAM**



Agragami is implementing the Project at 131 villages covering a population of 1, 37,143nos. in Jhalda-I Block under Purulia district since 2007. The Laboratory is run by Agragami with financial and Technical support of Public Health Engineering Dept. Govt. Of West Bengal, this was initially setup with assistance of UNICEF under Fluoride Mitigation Program.

# Construction of Soak pit, Drain & Platform



Hand pump fitted Tube wells the major drinking water sources in in rural areas of Purulia having no proper drainage system for disposal of wastewater resulting contamination of ground water sources. And to combat the situation Agragami has been

implementing "Const. of Soak pit. Surface Drain & Platform for Liquid Waste Management from spot Source including Training & IEC" a CSR initiative of PHE Deptt. with COAL India Ltd' & SIPL, in different GPs under Neturia Block of Purulia district. The main objectives of the project are (i) To Protect the drinking water sources (Hand-Pump) from cross-contamination (ii) To manage wastewater form handpump in scientific technology to the underground (iii) recharge Community are made aware to manage the safe water sources from contamination and maintain & (iv) Minimize sanitation chances of-Waterborne diseases. usefulness Sensitization on maintaining hygiene practices for safe drinking water were provided as a part of the program. During the reported period construction of 74 nos. soak pit completed followed by 12 nos. sensitization program.



#### **Mobile Medical Unit**

Access to health care and equitable distribution of health services are the fundamental requirements for achieving the Millennium Development Goals.. And with that view the government has launched the Mobile Medical Unit under NHM in some selected blocks in October,2011. Taking health care to the doorsteps is the principle behind this initiative and intended to reach underserved areas. Agragami has been entrusted by West Bengal Health and Family Welfare Samiti & NHM in running Mobile Medical Units (MMU) in 6No. GPs of Jhalda-I, 5No. GPs at Saltora & 3No. GPs under Khatra block of Purulia & Bankura district of West Bengal.

# Rogi Sahayata Kendra (RSK)

PDAMSMS is implementing Rogi Sahayata Kendra at Raghunathpur Sub-Divisional Hospital Purulia since June,2011 and at Jhalda, Jaypur, Baghmundi BPHCs & Koteshila Rural Hospital under Jhalda-I Subdivision & at Ragthunathpur, Para with support from NRHM, H &FW Deptt. Govt. of West Bengal with a view to providing information about the services available in the health facility to all clients and stakeholders. to disseminate all patients related information to patients and relatives on a real-time basis so that they may access the available services fully and without delay, and to assist the service providers of the health facility of Govt. by appropriately guiding the patients/visitors.

# **LINK WORKERS SCHEME (LWS):**

**AGRAGAMI** has been implementing Link Workers Scheme (LWS) project for High Risk Group Population & their spouses in partnership with West Bengal State AIDS Prevention & Control Society (WBSAP&CS), H&FW Deptt. Govt. Of West Bengal & NACO since 2016. The project is being implemented at 100 villages in 15 blocks of Paschim Medinipore District—covering 350189 population.

The main objective of the programme is to halt and reverse the epidemic by integrating programme for prevention, care, support and to address the issues like: Condom Promotion (Promotion/Distribution of Condoms), Social Marketing, Develop Inter-personal Behaviour Changes Communication, Community Mobilization and IEC activities, health camp organisation for Referral and linkage service, Linkage to Integrated Counselling and Testing Centers (ICTC), Creation of enabling environment (Advocacy for Enabling Environment) etc.

Under this Project **AGRAGAMI** has taken different program activities during this year:

#### **Condom Promotion**

The intervention has planned for promotion of correct and consistent use of condom among the target population by making groups condom 3A i.e. accessibility, availability & affordability. increasing access to the condom, free condoms has supplied by the project. Besides, the CLWs & LVs are also supplying the free condom as per their estimated demand regularly during counselling sessions.

# **Health Camps**

During this period **AGRAGAMI** has organized 16 health camps in the outreach areas. The health camps ware organized as per the need of the community in the inaccessible areas with the support of the Health Depts. Officials. Local MLAs, PRI representatives & other dignitaries remain present in those camps to encourage the local peoples including targeted population of the

# **Menstrual Hygiene Management Program**

Menstruation and menstrual practice remains as a taboo and socio-cultural restriction for women and adolescent girls, yet it is not spoken about openly causing unnecessary embarrassment and shame among the community.



There is a traditional practice still continuing in the community such as using clothes as absorbent and reused for several months after wash. There is also an overpowering concern to keep drying and airing of cloths in their house, that result in ending poor hygienic and health concern. Although poor Sanitation is correlated with absenteeism and drop out of the girls, efforts in school sanitation to address this issue have ignored menstrual management in toilet design and construction mainly for girls' toilet.

## **Adolescent Intervention Program**

'Adolescent Intervention Program', empowering adolescents through their rights, has been designed by UNICEF with the support of Purulia District Administration to improve the adolescent's life in the age group of 10 to 19 years. The Program aims to achieve better outcomes in the area of adolescent's development, Health & Nutrition, Education, and Protection & Empowerment through information and skill development.

Goals of the program are -: (i)20% reduction in child marriage;(ii)20% increase in adolescent's enrollment in secondary education & (iii)10% decrease in prevalence of girls aged 15-19 who are already mothers or pregnant by 2018.

AGRAGAMI is implementing the project at Purulia-II block and Jhalda Municipality of Purulia district and works directly with the target beneficiaries to address the gaps in intervention area.
